Grade School	
Kindergarten, 1,3,4,5	<i>Mass and Classes</i> are held weekly on Sunday mornings from 9:30-10:45 a.m. Children study the <i>Faith First</i> curriculum from RCL-Resources for Christian Living.
Grade 2	Sacraments Year!! Materials for classroom and home use prepare the children to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation in (December) and Eucharist in (May).
Middle School	
Grades 6-8	Classes meet on Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Special classes will be offered during the year. Students study the <i>Catholic Connections</i> curriculum from St. Mary's Press.
Confirmation Preparation:	<i>All High School Students Please Read Thoroughly.</i>
	<i>Please remember that Confirmation preparation is a three-year process. Confirmation usually is celebrated in the junior year of high school. Two prior years of religious education, either in a Catholic high school or through the Youth Ministry program, are required for candidates for the sacrament. The Confirmation program in junior year includes all eligible members of the parish -- both Catholic high school and public high school students.</i>
Grade 9	All parish students attending a public high school this fall will participate in this program. The classes meet monthly on Monday evenings 6:30-8:30 p.m. Day of Reflection: Sunday, September 25, 2011 at Camp Minikani.
Grade 10	Classes meet monthly on Monday evenings 6:30-8:30 p.m. Retreat: November 4-5, 2011 Camp Whitcomb Mason.
Grade 11	The Confirmation program emphasizes discipleship and includes immediate preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. Classes normally meet monthly on Monday evenings from 6:30-8:30 p.m. Retreat: February 24-26, 2012- James Lodge, Camp Whitcomb Mason.
